

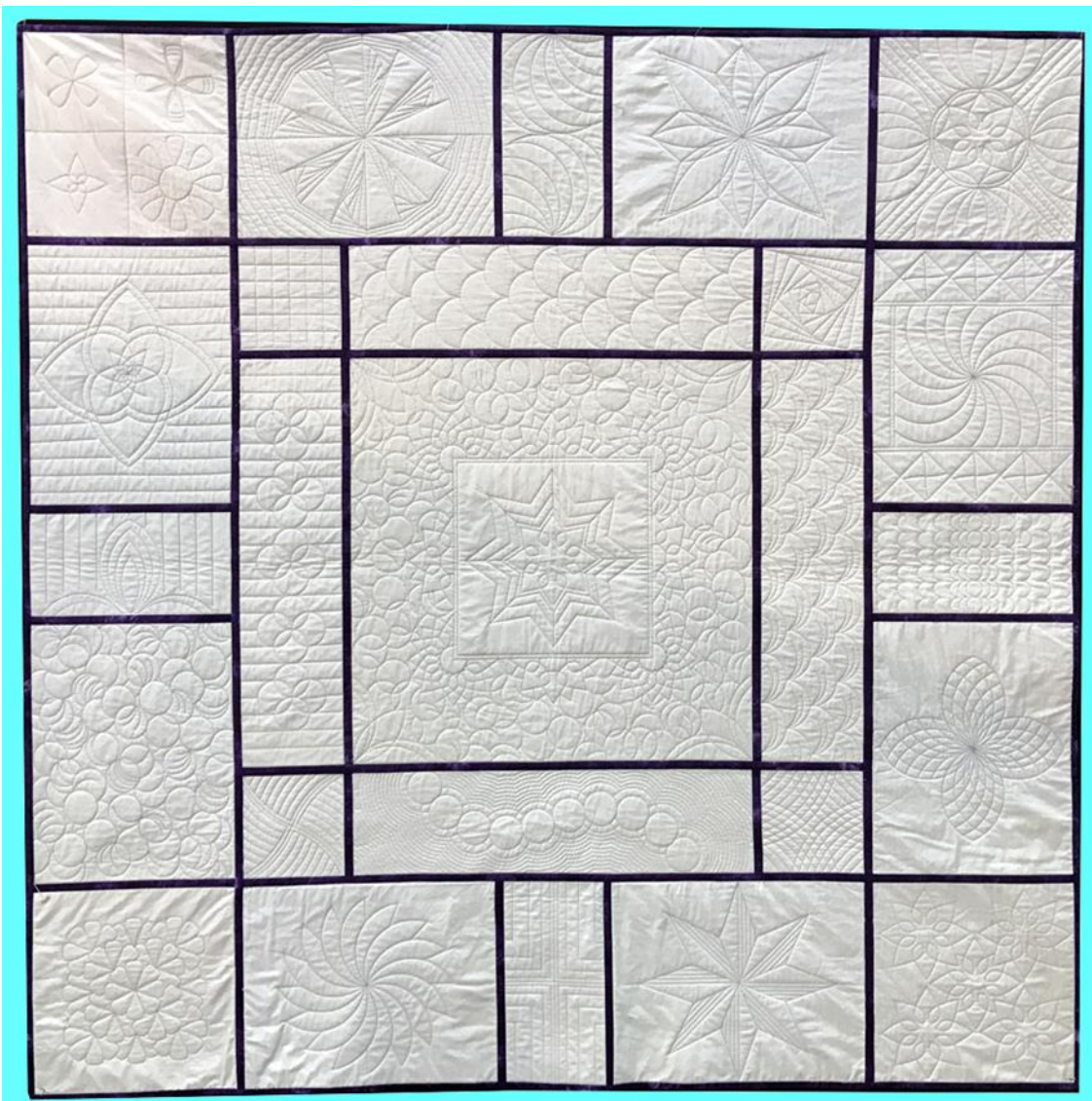
Westalee 'Block of the Month' – Intro Letter

Attached you will have a fabric requirement list and a cutting guide. I have also attached the requirements for the Westalee Ruler class as they are relevant as a reminder of what you should bring. Whilst all of the blocks will need to be cut out, the only one you need for the first lesson will be 4 of Block F, 10 inch square of backing, batting and top fabric.

When choosing your fabric, choose a tone on tone or plain fabric for the top and a plain Homespun or Calico for the backing and use the same wadding for all blocks (which ever you prefer to use ie; cotton, wool, or a mix).

For joining the blocks together, you can get a contrasting fabric or use the same as your blocks.

You don't have to use all the same fabric for the top. Which is a good way to use up fabrics you already have.



When selecting your thread, choose one that you are used to using and a colour that will be noticed. The aim of this quilt is to show off your quilting.

There will be a lot to get through each lesson and I suggest perhaps taking some reference photos in case we run out of time then you will be able to finish some at home.
